1. Preamble

Chittagong University of Engineering and Technology (CUET), Khulna University of Engineering and Technology (KUET) and Rajshahi University of Engineering and Technology (RUET) organize a combined admission test for students admission in the various departments offering the Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) in respective Engineering field of study, Bachelor of Urban and Regional Planning (BURP) and Bachelor of Architecture (B. Arch) degrees under different faculties on Sunday 03 March 2024 at 10:00 am for the academic year 2023-2024 for the prescribed seats as mentioned in Section 2 in three centers (CUET, KUET and RUET) with the same question paper.

- a. The examination center will be decided according to the grade points and marks obtained by the candidate in the four subjects, namely Mathematics, Science, Chemistry and English in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination and the candidate's preference.
- b. The university and the department for admission will be determined according to the merit rank obtained in the admission test by the candidate and his/her preference.
- c. Application for admission, admission procedure regarding university and department selection order of the candidates who have qualified the admission test will be done online (<https://admissionckruet.ac.bd>).

2. Number of Seats

Number of seats for admission in 4 (four) year B.Sc. in Engineering and BURP (Group “Ka”) and 5 (Five) Year B. Arch (Group “Kha”) under the three Universities (CUET, KUET & RUET) is as follows:

3. Qualifications for Participation in the Admission Test

- Candidate must be a citizen of Bangladesh.
- The candidate must have passed the S.S.C. or equivalent examination from any Secondary & Higher Secondary Education Board/Madrassa Education Board/Technical Education Board of Bangladesh in the year 2020 or 2021 with minimum GPA of 4.00 or equivalent grade.
- Candidate must have passed Higher Secondary/Alim/equivalent examination held in 2023 from any Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education/Madrassa Education Board/Board of Technical Education in Bangladesh or GCE 'A' level on or after November 2022. Candidates should have minimum total grade points of 14.00 in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry and a minimum grade point of 3.50 in English; however, the candidate must have minimum total grade points of 18.00 in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English. Besides, for admission in the Biomedical Engineering Department, the concerned candidate must obtain at least grade point 4.00 in Biology in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination.
- Candidates those have passed GCE 'O' level must obtained 'A' grade separately in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English to appear in the admission test examination. And in the GCE 'A' level examination, the candidate must obtain 'A' grades in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics separately. Besides, to get admission in Biomedical Engineering Department, the concerned candidate should get at least 'B' grade in Biology in GCE 'A' level examination.
- Candidates, Bangladesh nationals, who have passed the Higher Secondary/Equivalent Examination held in 2022 from a foreign educational institution with at least 12 academic years of study must obtained at least 80% marks or equivalent grade in the Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English separately. The concerned candidate must have obtained at least 70% marks in average or equivalent grade in the secondary/equivalent examination.

4. Subjects and Syllabus for Admission Test

- Admission Test of the following two groups (Ka & Kha) will be held on the same day and at the same time.
Group Ka: Engineering Departments and URP Department
Group Kha: Engineering Departments, URP Department and Architecture Department

- Distribution of Marks in Admission test:

Applicant of 'Group Ka' and 'Group Kha' needs to appear in an MCQ examination of 500 marks for 2 hours and 30 min duration at first. In addition, applicant for 'Group Kha' must appear to a separate Free-hand drawing examination of 200 marks for 1 hour duration at the same seat.

5. Minimum Qualifications for Admission

- The merit rank of an eligible candidate will be determined on the basis of total marks obtained in the admission test only. A merit list for Engineering Departments and Urban and Regional Planning Department, and a separate merit list for Architecture Department will be published for the eligible candidates according to their merit position based on obtained total marks.
- In the case of more than one candidate obtaining the same total marks in the admission test, for Engineering Departments and Urban and Regional Planning Department, the marks obtained in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English in order of admission test, and that for Architecture Department, merit rank of candidates will be determined on the basis of marks obtained in Free-hand drawing, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English in order.
- Separate merit list of eligible candidates for admission in the reserved seats will be published. However, in any individual department a maximum of 02 (two) qualified candidates will be admitted to CUET and 01 (one) each to KUET and RUET in the order of merit and preference in each category.

6. Application Rules for Participation in admission Test (Applicable to Candidates Passed from Education Boards of Bangladesh)

To participate in the admission test, the prescribed application form has to be filled online only. Candidates will need a soft copy (.jpg format) of recently taken color photograph (not more than three months, 300×300 pixel, 200 kB maximum) and a signature (300×80 pixel, 150 kB maximum) to complete the application. Applicants have to pay a prescribed fee which can be paid through Debit Card/Credit Card/Mobile Banking or Internet Banking.

To apply follow the following steps:

Step 1: First enter <https://admissionckruet.ac.bd> and click on ‘**Admission Portal**’ button. At the beginning (for the first time user/New user) click on the ‘**New Applicant**’ button to check the minimum eligibility criterion set for the admission application.

Step 2: Carefully fill in the Board, SSC & HSC Roll No., Registration No. and Year of passing to continue.

Step 3: If you are considered eligible, ‘**Apply Now**’ button will be appeared and click the ‘**Apply Now**’ button. After that, a mobile number needs to given for setting login ID (HSC Registration No.) and Password in the system as an registered **Existing User** using the OTP received on the given mobile number from the Admission Secretariat. As the mobile number will be used for any further communication until end of the admission process, care must be taken in giving the number and the number cannot be changed later on in any circumstance.

Step 4: Application submission form will be available in this step. Candidate must fill all the details. Select the group (A or B) and give the exam center preference for all the three different centers. Candidates applying for the reserved seats have to select their required quota in this step. As per the instructions given above, the

applicant should upload recent (not more than 3 months) color photograph and signature. The applicant can see a preview screen subjected to filling all the required information. All information must be confirmed and click on ‘**I Agree**’ check box.

Step 5: In next step, applicant can either click ‘**Save and Exit**’ button to exit the system or at the same time click on the ‘**Proceed for the Payment**’ button to go to the payment gateway. For payment in later, applicant has to log in again as ‘**Existing User**’ users on the ‘**Admission Portal**’ and then confirm again reviewing the saved information given earlier before click on the ‘**Proceed for the Payment**’ button to go to the payment gateway.

Step 6: Candidates have to pay the prescribed application fee, as shown in Table below through Debit Card/Credit Card/Mobile Banking or Internet Banking in the payment gateway. If the payment is done correctly, “Payment is successful” message on the screen. Following successful completion of payment, applicant can download ‘**Application Form**’ and the ‘**Payment Receipt**’ from the ‘**Admission Dashboard**’. Applicant are advised to take all the print out in color and keep these safely for further necessity.

Step 7: Upon publishing the list of eligible candidates to participate in the admission test, the eligible candidates need to go the admission website (<https://admissionckruet.ac.bd>) and click on ‘**Admission Portal**’ button of online application system, and provide Application ID (HSC Registration No.) and Password to the ‘**Existing Users**’ and log in to download Application form and Payment Receipt, Admit Card from the ‘**Admission Dashboard**’

- In case of GCE 'O' and GCE 'A' Level applicants go to the ‘**Admission Portal**’ button and click on “‘**A**’ level applicants/Bangladeshi national (foreign institutions)’ button and fill the necessary information. Scanned copy of GCE O and A Level or equivalent examination grade sheet along with all information should be uploaded in one zip file.
- If you select Quota, you have to upload the Quota related certificate in .jpeg format.

Collection of Admit Card:

- After publishing the list of eligible candidates to participate in the admission test, the eligible applicant has to visit <https://admissionckruet.ac.bd> website and login to the ‘**Admission Portal**’ using login credentials. Admit card in pdf format can be downloaded from ‘**Admission Dashboard**’. Admit card should be printed in color on A4 size white paper. No candidate will be allowed to participate in the admission test without the admit card.

Note:

- It is advised to take special care and follow the instructions well while applying through online mode.
- No further changes can be made after completing the online application process.
- Online application can be made anytime within the prescribed date and time.

- Candidates who have passed from foreign educational institutions or candidates who have passed GCE 'O' level and GCE 'A' level can apply through online. However, the applicant has to apply on the integrated admission test website (<https://admissionkruet.ac.bd>) by paying the prescribed application fee and uploading the following documents in .jpeg format.
 - i. Scanned copy of original marks sheet of Secondary or equivalent/GCE 'O' level examination.
 - ii. Scanned copy of original marks sheet of Higher Secondary or equivalent/GCE 'A' level examination.
- Candidates have to follow the rules mentioned in the admission brochure. To have any information related to admission however, not mentioned in the admission brochure can be contacted on the above mentioned mobile numbers and e-mail.

7. Determination of Eligible Candidates for Admission Test

- a. An eligible candidate list will be prepared on the basis of the total Grade points obtained in the four subjects of Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination from among the applications received online within the specified period. If the grade points are same then merit place in the the list of eligible candidate will be determined on the basis of total marks obtained in the order of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics/ Physics and Chemistry total marks/ Physics marks/ and Chemistry marks. The first 30,000 (thirty thousand) eligible candidates from this merit list get the opportunity to participate in the admission test. However, all 30,000 (thirty thousand) candidates will be given an opportunity to participate in the admission examination. It should be noted that among the applicants who will not be considered eligible to participate in the admission test, excluding the processing fee subject to the application within the specified time through the prescribed form provided on the website the remaining amount will be refunded.
- b. All eligible applicants who have obtained GCE 'O' level and GCE 'A' level examination results subject to meeting the minimum qualifications will be eligible to participate in the admission test.
- c. All eligible applicants for reserved seats subject to fulfilling the minimum qualifications will be considered eligible to participate in the admission test.
- d. The complete list of candidates eligible to participate in the admission test will be given on the notice board of each university, on the university's own website and on the integrated admission test website (<https://admissionkruet.ac.bd>) candidates will know it at their own responsibility.

8. Admission Test Rules

- a. Based on the education boards prescribed syllabus for Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English (Functional English) for Higher Secondary Examination 2023, a Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) type examination will be made for admission test for both the Group "Ka" and Group "Kha". An additional free hand drawing test will be held for Group "Kha" for Architecture department admission as an integral part of aforesaid MCQ examination.
- b. For each wrong answer in the MCQ examination, 25% of the marks allotted for the respective question will be deducted from the total marks obtained for correct answers.
- c. If more than one circle is filled in the answer to the same question in the OMR Sheet, the answer will be considered wrong.
- d. Circles can be filled in OMR Sheet only with black ink ball point pen. Pencil, gel pen or fountain pen cannot be used to fill circles on OMR based answer script. Pencil is to be used for freehand drawing examination.
- e. For Group "Kha", candidates will submit the question paper and OMR Sheet after the completion of Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English subject examination to be held at first part. Then 15 minutes later in the same seat, the free hand drawing examination will start at 12:45 PM for an hour duration.

- f. Mobile phone, smart watch, or any other digital device, geometry box, pencil box, scale, set-square, compass and any kind of bag are strictly prohibited in the examination hall and it is advised not to enter into the examination hall with such items.
- g. The examination will be deemed to be canceled if there is any sort of occurrence of rudeness or misbehavior with anyone in the examination hall with the applicant is found. Candidates will not be allowed to enter the hall after 30 minutes from the commencement of the examination and will not be allowed to leave the examination room unless 1 hour has elapsed after the commencement of the examination.
- h. On the day of the admission test, the candidate must bring the original registration card of the HSC/equivalent examination and the hard copy (color print) of the downloaded admit card for this combined admission test.
- i. Only ballpoint pens, pencils, erasers and calculators can be brought during the admission test. Only the calculator of the model mentioned in the table below can be used, other than this, no other model of calculator can be used. A candidate can bring and use maximum 2 (two) calculators in the examination hall.

h) The time and date of admission, orientation, class start and other admission related information will be published on the notice board and in the website of every concerned university (CUET, KUET and RUET) along with the website of the Combined Admission Test (https://admissionckruet.ac.bd). No notices in respect to Admission test date, admission and others, as appropriate, will be sent to any newspapers nor will any letter to be sent individually to any applicant and/or eligible candidate for admission test and admission thereafter.				

Special Note:

- i. The online application submission process will close after 11:59 PM on Wednesday, 07 February 2024. After that applicant can no longer be able to submit application online. Point to be noted that there is no offline application system is available at any stage of application submission.
- ii. All information related to admission and seats will be found on each university's notice board and its website, and combined admission test website (<https://admissionckruet.ac.bd>). No letter will be issued separately to applicants and later on to the admitted students.
- iii. Due to special circumstances, the date and schedule mentioned in Clause 9 may be changed. Amendments or necessary information in this regard will be published on the admission test website (<https://admissionckruet.ac.bd>).

10. Selection of university and department of the eligible candidate

- a. Preference order will be taken from all candidates seeking admission in merit list through Online using Combined Admission Test website (<https://admissionckruet.ac.bd>) which cannot be changed later. Detailed instructions for online selection will be communicated on the website/notice at the time of publication of admission test results.
- b. University and department of the admitted candidates will be determined according to the merit rank obtained in the admission test and the order of preference of the candidates submitted.
- c. General candidates and reserved seat candidates will be admitted to the three universities on the scheduled days according to the merit list in accordance with the admission rules. The admitted candidates will be informed about the university and department received, total number of vacant seats and list of candidates selected for next admission before the scheduled date of next admission.
- d. Candidates eligible for admission to Engineering and Urban and Regional Planning Departments shall submit a choice list with 39 (thirty nine) separate choices and candidates eligible for admission to Architecture Departments shall submit a choice list with 03 (three) choices (CUET Arch., KUET Arch. and RUET Arch.). If a candidate wants to take admission in Architecture Departments after taking admission in Engineering and Urban and Regional Planning Departments, he/she has to cancel the admission in Engineering and Urban and Regional Planning Departments and take admission in Architecture Departments. Later candidates will not be considered for Engineering and Urban and Regional Planning departments. Similarly, if a candidate wants to take admission in Engineering and Urban and Regional Planning Departments after taking admission in Architecture Departments, then he/she has to cancel the admission from Architecture Departments and take admission in Engineering and Urban and Regional Planning Departments. Later that candidate will not be considered for Architecture departments. In both cases the candidate will not be required to pay the admission fee for such changes.
- e. The admission process will continue till the day before the orientation of Level 1 class on the same date and time at CUET, KUET and RUET, in general subject to the seats not being filled in this system. If any seat becomes vacant due to cancellation of admission, auto-migration will be done according to candidate's merit rank and preference. A candidate can stop the auto-migration within the specified time frame after getting the department and university of his/her choice. Note that once auto-migration is turned off, it cannot be turned back on.
- f. The candidate who has got the opportunity to participate in the admission test of the university has to complete the admission process in that university. Irrespective of the university in which the candidate is admitted, according to the candidate's merit rank and preference, the classes should be started in the university and department received after the completion of the last auto-migration.
- g. If any admitted candidate wants to cancel the admission, he/she can cancel the admission from the admitted university (the university to which the admission documents have been submitted) up to the day before the orientation in accordance with the cancellation rules. However, cancellation of the admission after the start of the class, student has to do it according to the rules of the respective university where he/she started classes.

11. Eligible Candidates Admission Procedure:

- a. Candidates have to fill and submit the prescribed form for admission online. The choice of university and department for admission cannot be changed after online submission.

The papers required for submission at the time of Admission:

- i. The original registration card of HSC or Equivalent examination issued by the education board
- ii. The original certificate of SSC or Equivalent examination
- iii. The original copy of grade-sheet of SSC or Equivalent examination
- iv. The original copy of grade-sheet of HSC or Equivalent examination

- v. The original copy of the testimonial of HSC or Equivalent examination issued by the principal of the Educational Institutions
- vi. Newly taken (not more than three months) 2 (two) copies of passport size color photos (not attested)
- vii. The signed admit card of the Combined Admission Test
- viii. Additional documents required for admission in reserved seats:

-The original copy of the small ethnic group certificate or the tribe certificate. The candidates of Rakhain community and small ethnic group (tribe) are to submit the following 3 (three) documents as the proof of their permanent residence and tribe identity of Bangladesh: (i) the certificate given by the principal of the college from where he/she passed the HSC, (ii) The certificate given by the deputy commissioner or the chairman of local municipal/district parishad/union parishad and (iii) the certificate given by the head of the tribe community.

Or

-The original copy of the certificate for permanent residence of Bandarban district given by the deputy commissioner/the chairman of local municipal/district parishad/union parishad.

- b. The candidates will undergo verification of authenticity of certificates by the admission scrutiny Committee and medical examination by the Medical Board consisting of University Health Officers.
- c. If found qualified in the health examination, the original grade sheets and original/provisional certificates must be submitted to the University for a period of two years by submitting the requisite prescribed admission fee within the prescribed period with the approval of the Admission Committee. The said certificates can be returned before two years only by cancellation of admission.
- d. No separate letter will be sent to the selected candidates for information and notification regarding admission and commencement of classes. The candidate will know all the information regarding admission and subsequent commencement of classes on his/her own responsibility. All information regarding this is available on the notice board of each university, its own website and the combined admission test website (<https://admissionckruet.ac.bd>).

12. Admission Process for Foreign Students

Foreign students seeking admission should apply through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Ministry of Education of the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh. Applications should reach the respective universities by 30 July 2024.

13. Cancellation of Admission/Eligibility for Admission

- a. A candidate will not be considered eligible for admission if he/she does not appear on the scheduled day of admission.
- b. Admitted students can apply for cancellation of admission only themselves. No chance of cancellation of admission through guardian or any other person is permitted.
- c. If any information provided by the admitted student is subsequently proved to be incorrect, his/her admission and studentship can be deemed canceled.

14. Health Check

The University to which the candidate will be admitted will conduct a medical examination of all candidates considered for admission by a Medical Board consisting of University Health Officers. If the health examination reveals heart, vision or hearing impairment or any physical or mental disability, as a result of which it appears to the

admission committee that it may be impossible for the candidate to study at the university or to carry out professional activities, then he/she will be considered unsuitable for admission. Candidates selected for admission should come with the report of Blood Group Test from any established diagnostic center on the day of admission and submit it to the medical board constituted by the concerned university. As per the decision of the medical board constituted for the purpose of admission, the necessary medical test report should be submitted as per the instructions of the concerned medical board. Students wearing spectacles must carry spectacles on the day of medical test. The prescribed form of health examination can be downloaded from the Combined Admission Test website (<https://admissionckruet.ac.bd>).

15. Reserved Seats

Seats will be reserved for admission in the three universities as per the table below. For admission to the reserved seat, there should be eligibility as per the order of merit mentioned in clause-5(c). No other type of seat is reserved for admission in any way.

16. Residential Hall Seats

There is no guarantee of seat for the students (Male/Female) admitted in Level 1 for the academic session 2023-2024. In that case, the student will have to arrange accommodation on his/her own responsibility.

Special Note:

- i. Attempts to influence any faculty, officer or employee of the University regarding admission will disqualify the candidate.
- ii. The decision of the Central Admission Committee (Academic Year: 2023-2024) in any matter related to admission will be considered final.
- iii. After the commencement of classes, the student should continue his/her education as per the rules of the respective university.
- iv. If the admission test is held under special circumstances, one must participate in the admission test following all the hygiene rules as per the government instructions.

The Central Admission Committee reserves the right to change, amend, add and re-add any clause and sub-clause of the admission rules.
